Installation

To install your new theme, double-click the theme icon, titled **heatwave.rwtheme**. Rapidweaver will install the theme and then pop-up a dialog box informing you that the theme is installed and that you now need to quit and restart RapidWeaver.

After exiting and then restarting RapidWeaver you will find your theme installed and ready to use inside the theme drawer.

Upgrades and updates

If you're upgrading from a previous version of a theme you will need to delete your old version before installing the new one. To do so, right-click (or ctrl-click) on the theme in the theme drawer and select delete. After deleting the previous version follow the above steps to install the new version.

* Be warned, deleting your theme will get rid of any data stored in it, such as custom headers, modified code, customized graphics, etc. Be sure to back up the data before deleting your old theme, if necessary.

Hot stuff

Heat Wave is an impressive new theme for RapidWeaver that is simple, yet very flexible. Its clean look is great for designing a portfolio, blog, small business site and much more. This theme makes it easy to create a simply brilliant looking site in a short period of time!



Width

Heat Wave offers great flexibility when it comes to the width of your site. You're able to choose from the following widths (the default value is bolded):

- 700 px
- 750 px
- **800 px**
- 850 px
- 900 px



Header

This theme is bursting at the seams with highly polished, beautifully designed headers.

Heat Wave has 22 built-in headers to choose from, along with 10 blank headers that you can use to create your own look using RWmultitool.

Sidebar

In this theme you're able to place the sidebar in 2 different locations, or turn it off altogether.

You can place the sidebar on the right- or left-hand side of the site.

Do note however that when turning off the sidebar it will also hide any related sub menus for that page.

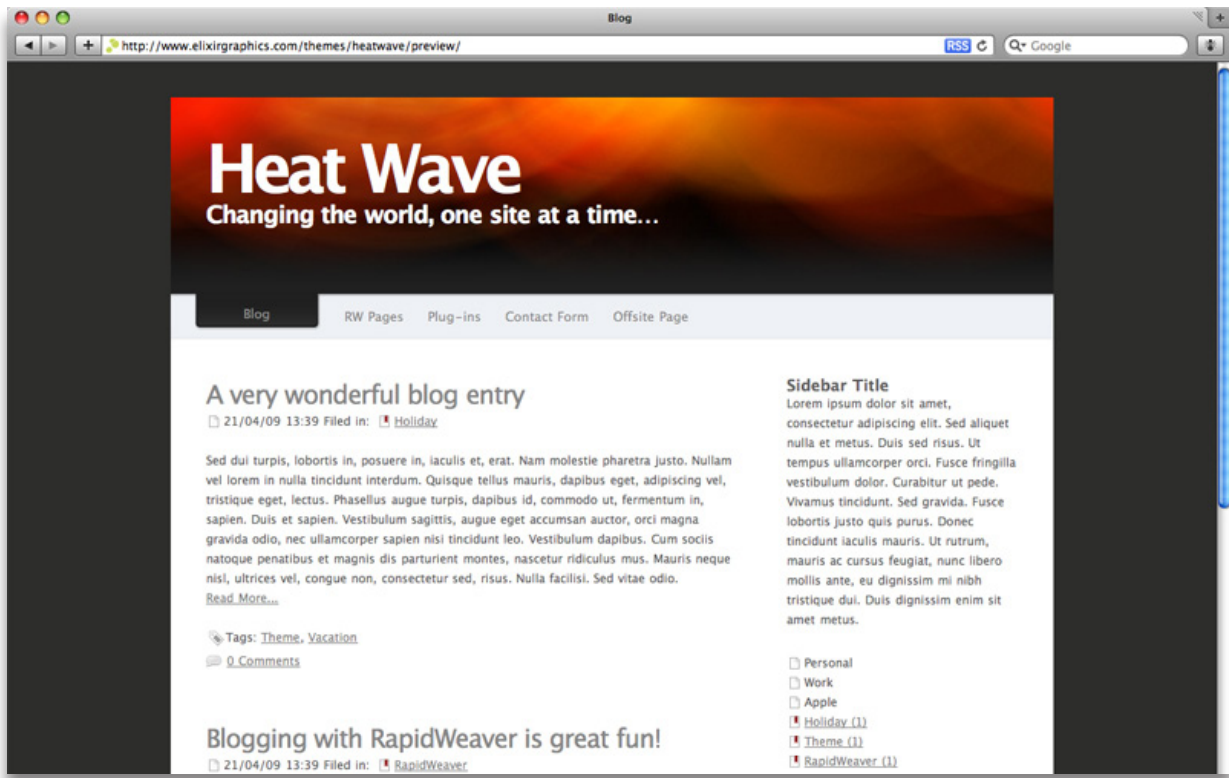
Navigation

Heat Wave sports a split navigation menu system similar to that of our Aqua and Espresso themes.

The top level, or parent menu, is located horizontally beneath the header image.

The secondary, or child menu items, are located at the top of the sidebar (when visible). You can see the split navigation menu at work in our preview site.

We also 4 different styles for the horizontal menu, as well as 3 styles for the submenus in the sidebar.



Colors

This theme integrates RapidWeaver's color picker. Using the color picker, you can easily edit the look and feel of your site. All without ever touching any code!

You can edit these parts of the theme with the color picker:

- Menu background
- Site Background
- Links
- Body Font
- Site Title
- Site Slogan
- Content Border
- Breadcrumb Trail Text
- Breadcrumb Trail Background
- Menu Text (Horizontal)
- Sub menu Background Bar
- Sub menu Text



Font selection

Heat Wave allows you to modify the font style for the Site Title and Slogan and Body.

You can also choose different font sizes for the Title and Slogan.

Note: Fonts display differently across different operating systems and browsers. Compatible fonts have been chosen for other browsers. For instance, in Windows your users will see Arial instead of Helvetica.
